- Use whatever drawing materials you are most comfortable with: Graphite Pencil (wooden or mechanical 2mm) – 2B, HB, 2H (you can bring a wider range if you wish)
- Charcoal Medium and soft (Nitram Brand) Hard Charcoal: Winsor and Newton. (or equivalent) No willow or compressed charcoal or charcoal pencil.
- Erasers kneaded for charcoal or a white one for pencil. 2mm eraser (such as the Tombow Mono

Zero eraser) is a thin eraser great for small adjustments if you are using graphite.

• Sandpaper 220 grit for sharpening charcoal. For pencils you will need a sharpener or blade.

Paper:

Strathmore pencil paper 400 for pencil and some cheaper sketching paper for practice. For charcoal, a sold brand is strathmore charcoal- white or toned light gray.

I will be demoing on smooth pastelmat.

Optional:

If you want to experiment with some colored pencils to draw with this is a great option:

- Pastel pencil such as Faber-Castell Pitt Pastels or other pastel (choose options that are chalky rather than waxy): in White, one or the other of Raw Umber (#180), Bistre (#179) of equivalent.
- Feel free to bring other colors if you wish.

Bring a brush if you wish to use it to lightly move charcoal around.
