Drawing Supplies

- Charcoal – willow medium sticks, loose
- Charcoal pencils – HB, 2B and 4B – 2-3 of each
- Kneaded eraser – large size
- Gum eraser – it's a square block, tan
- Paper – Your choice. White, tan or gray – size 18x24 Strathmore pad, wire bound

I will always have paper and misc. stuff on hand so no stress there.

Painting Supplies

Oil or acrylic is fine.

Titanium White (large tube if possible)	Ultramarine Blue
Cadmium Yellow Medium	Cerulean Blue – Just because Ultramarine can be overwhelming at times.
Cadmium Red Medium	

- There is a wide range of paint available – watch pricing but do not buy student grade paint. It's too thin and transparent for the most part.
- Utrecht, Gamblin, Golden, Liquitex are decent brands. Windsor Newton is good as well, if a bit pricey.
- We will incorporate more colors as we progress but this is a decent start.

Brushes

#4, 6 and 10 filbert or flat. Eventually you will need a couple of rounds.

Canvas Panels

8 to 10 canvas panels, 8x10 and 11x14. Don't bother right now with linen. Cotton acrylic primed panels will work well as a start.
