Naples Yellow (Da Vinci),

Yellow Ocher

Permanent Green, or Hookers Green,

Cerulean Blue

Lavender (Holbein or Da Vinci)

Cobalt Blue

French Ultramarine Blue

Light Red or Burnt Sienna

Cobalt Violet *optional

Water container and household sponge

Paper:

You are recommend to use a quality paper, not student grade paper. I use several different kinds of 140 lb cold pressed paper:

Arches, Winsor & Newton, Waterford, Lanaquarelle

Moulin Du Roy by Canson

If you have a favorite, by all means use it.

Brushes:

Use what you're used to, but I typically use:

1" and 1½" muslin brushes;

1" flat at both short and long

1/2" flat

#6, #10, #14 round synthetic sable mix.

It is also useful to have a #5 or #6 bristle

Landscape reference photos to work from, printed or digital. Using your own photos is recommended for a more personal result.
